

- Open up and type in your email address, click **next**
- Click new user. An email will be sent to set your password.
- Once set you will see your child's/children's photo and be able to access the parent portal.

Many of you have already downloaded the app and are beginning to interact with it, thank you so much. If you have any difficulties please let us know and we can help you out, or if you do not get the reset password email or it bounces back it may mean that the email address we have for your family is incorrect. Please update these details with the office as soon as you can.

Our Meet the Teacher/Goal Setting Interviews are being held next week - Tuesday and Thursday. Please check your child's bag today as those of you who have booked a time will have information sent home today. There is a page for you to fill out about your child's strengths and interests. We do encourage your children to be part of the discussion, please bring them along. If you still wish to book a time you can. There are limited places on Tuesday, but quite a few available on Thursday.

Coming up on the **29th of February are the Waimea Athletics**. This involves Riversdale, Balfour, Waikaia and Garston (only their year 7&8s) Schools.
