#### Kia Ora Parents and Whanau

Welcome to the new school year. We hope you all got a summer break, relaxing in the sun. We have welcomed several new students and their families to our school community; Blake Sloane, Carter Wilson (and parents Julie and Gavin) and Amalia Trent (and parents Jordyn and Shannon). We have also welcomed new teachers Miss Keralee Marshall (in Room 7) and Mrs Jo Smith (in Room 5). This year we also have a student teacher working in the school 2 days per week in Room 1, Miss Alice Hishon.

On Monday 12th February, 10am, we are holding a Mihi Whakatau to welcome our new students and staff to Riversdale School. All parents are welcome to attend. A Mihi Whakatau is a Māori welcome similar to a powhiri on a marae, but less formal. We intend to do this twice a year to welcome our new families and staff. Please feel free to come along and stay for morning tea at the conclusion.

On Tuesday 20th February and Thursday 22nd February we are planning to hold Teacher/Student/Parent Conferences for parents to come in and talk with your child's teacher to share information, meet each other and develop a couple of goals to work on for the year. We do encourage you to bring your children along so they can become part of the decision making process. The teachers will be working with the students in class to discuss possible goals as well. This year we have moved to a new student management system called Hero. In this system we keep student information, parent contact details, check attendance and much more. This system is also a platform to communicate with parents. In the past we have used School Stream to send out notices, newsletter, alerts etc, and this will still be used till March of this year. This communication will now be done through Hero. We are still learning how to use it ourselves, so there are bound to be some teething problems. Also through Hero you can report student absences. We would encourage you to go to your App Store and download the Hero App

- Search for Hero by linc-ed and download onto your phone
- Open up and type in your email address, click next
- Click **new user**. An email will be sent to set your password.
- Once set you will see your child's/children's photo and be able to access the parent portal.

If you have any difficulties please let us know and Miss McCall can help you out.

We are beginning our refresher Pause Breathe Smile lessons on Monday afternoons starting on the 12th of February, until the end of the term. Pause Breathe Smile is a healthy mind programme that teaches the students (and adults) ways of reducing anxiety and stress. It helps children to build self awareness, develop focused attention and to better cope with the normal ups and downs of life. If you have any questions please do not hesitate to ask. Coming up on the **29th of February are the Waimea Athletics**. This involves Riversdale, Balfour, Waikaia and Gartson (only their year 7&8s) Schools. We will all meet together at the Riversdale Sports ground on this date (1st March is our postponement day). Please save the date in your calendars and we will send out more information closer to the time. We will hold a working bee on Sunday 25th February at the grounds, time to be confirmed. We would appreciate helpers.

The new Government has recently communicated to us that there is a ban on students using cellphones at school. This has long been the policy at Riversdale School, but we would like to remind parents and students that cellphones are not necessary at school. If you need to contact your child throughout the day you can do so through the school office. We understand that there are times when your child may need to bring their phone to school, especially if there are afternoon sports/cultural activities. If they do bring them the phone is to stay in the school bag for the entirety of the day, or be handed in to the office to be picked up at 3:00pm. If you have any questions please do not hesitate to ask.

Our School has a sun protection policy that requires students to wear sun hats when outside during Terms 1 and 4 when the sun is at its fiercest. These hats are to be either brimmed (bucket hat style) or a legionnaires style, with flaps down the back to cover the ears and neck. Caps are not acceptable sun hat protection. Please ensure all students have their hats at school every day. We have a number of shade spaces around the school where students can get respite from the heat and sun. Even on cloudy days the UV intensity can be high.

We also require our students to wear their hi-vis safety vests to and from school daily. When your child enrols at Riversdale School the Home and School gift a vest, once that is too small or needs to be replaced this is a family responsibility. These can either be purchased from the Home and School for \$10 (cash only) or at Southern Workwear. Please ensure you help us to keep your children safe.

As always if you have any concerns regarding your child at school please contact your child's teacher in the first instance. If the matter needs further discussion then the principal will be brought into the conversation. We want to partner with you in your child's education, when we can talk about small things and resolve them we can stop big situations or issues from happening.
